## School Code of Conduct Rights & Responsibilities

At Chief Zzeh Gittlit School we recognize that each child and situation is unique and, in recognition of & respect for traditional Vuntut Gwitchin principles, values & knowledge, we will always strive to ensure our school is a safe, caring, and orderly environment in which to learn and work. The code of conduct at CZGS is based on the following balance of rights and responsibilities.

RIGHTS	RESPONSIBILITIES
Students have the right to learn.	Students have the responsibility to actively participate and be responsible learners.  Some examples include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Giving one's best effort</li><li>• Arriving on time and prepared for learning</li><li>• Supporting others in their learning</li></ul>
Students have the right to be respected.	Students have the responsibility to respect others.  Some examples include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Being polite and showing patience</li><li>• Demonstrating kindness</li><li>• Active listening</li><li>• Demonstrating honesty</li><li>• Respecting personal boundaries (personal space, privacy, possessions, etc.)</li></ul>
Students have the right to be safe.	Students have the responsibility to behave in a safe manner and to protect the safety of others.  Some examples include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Walking calmly in hallways</li><li>• Playing games safely &amp; respectfully</li><li>• Reporting dangerous situations to staff</li></ul>
Students have the right to use student equipment and property.	Students have the responsibility to use equipment and property of school according to all applicable rules with care and respect.  Some examples include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Cleaning up after yourself</li><li>• Asking before using equipment</li><li>• Returning materials on time and in good repair</li></ul>
